

The regular meeting of the Bristol Council was held in the Townhall on June 3rd, 2013 at 8:00 p.m. with Mayor Brent Orr, and Crs. Steve Forbes, Keith Smith, Colette O'Malley, Greg Graham, Brian Drummond and Debbie Kilgour.

**(13-06-83)** Motion Cr. Forbes that the minutes from the May 6<sup>th</sup> meeting be adopted as presented. Crd. The Mayor abstains from voting.

**(13-06-84)** Motion Cr. Drummond to adopt the agenda with the additions. Crd. The Mayor abstains from voting.

**(13-06-85)** Motion Cr. Forbes to accept the tender from Excavatech JL in the amount of \$322 791.16 taxes included for the improvements to Wharf Road. Crd. The Mayor abstains from voting.

**(13-06-86)** Assistance Program for the Maintenance of Local Roads

WHEREAS that the Ministry of Transport paid a compensation of \$ 475 336 for the maintenance of local roads for the civil year 2012;

WHEREAS that the distributed compensation to the municipality is for current and preventative maintenance of local roads 1 and 2 and includes bridge for which the municipality are responsible that are situated on these roads;

WHEREAS this resolution is accompanied by Annex A identifying the work completed by the municipality on the roads mentioned;

WHEREAS that an external auditor will present in the time frame allocated the accountability in Annex B or a special external verification report duly completed.

FOR THESE REASONS

It is proposed by Cr. Drummond, seconded by Cr. O'Malley and unanimously resolved and adopted that the Municipality of Bristol inform the Ministry of Transport of the use of the compensation for routine and preventative maintenance of local roads 1 and 2, including bridges on these roads for which the municipality is responsible in accordance with the objectives of the Program for the Maintenance of Local Roads. Crd. The Mayor abstains from voting.

- (13-06-87)** Motion Cr. Forbes that the Director General, Christina Peck, is authorized to submit the application to the Ministry of Natural Resources and Wildlife and the Ministry of Sustainable Development, Environment and Parks for the addition of sand on the access ways and public beach damaged by flooding. Crd. The Mayor abstains from voting.
- (13-06-88)** Motion Cr. Drummond to accept the subdivision plan submitted by Marilyn Antle for her properties located at 104 River Road and 26 White. Crd. The Mayor abstains from voting.
- (13-06-89)** Motion Cr. Smith to accept the application of Gary Hines to build an addition to his existing house. Crd. The Mayor abstains from voting.
- (13-06-90)** Ambulance Services
- WHEREAS the population of the Outaouais region has been growing for several years;
- WHEREAS the demand for pre-hospital emergency services has been steadily increasing for several years;
- WHEREAS the Ottawa Ambulance Services no longer meets the replacement coverage demands from the Agency for Health and Social Services of the Outaouais (ASSO);
- WHEREAS the solution from the ASSO is to transfer an ambulance from a rural area to cover the urban zone of Gatineau;
- WHEREAS this solution is detrimental to the citizens of this rural area;
- WHEREAS this lack of resources would create an increase in response times and this increase would have a direct impact resulting in increased mortality and morbidity rates of users;
- THEREFORE Motion Cr. Drummond that we support the Society of Paramedics of the Outaouais and request that the government take the appropriate measures in order to ensure, in the shortest possible delay, the weekly addition of 301 hours of ambulance coverage in the Gatineau area accompanied by the addition of another ambulance vehicle and the maintenance of ambulance coverage in the rest of the Outaouais region. Crd. The Mayor abstains from voting.

**(13-06-91)** Motion Cr. Kilgour to purchase the property of Peter & Joan Bauer located at 11 Ragged Chute Road for a sum of \$16 500. Crd. The Mayor abstains from voting.

**(13-06-92)** Motion Cr. Forbes to forward the application for the Municipal Road Improvement Help Program (PAARRM) to the office of Charlotte L'Ecuyer. Crd. The Mayor abstains from voting.

**(13-06-93)** Amalgamation

WHEREAS the Municipality of Bristol Council has studied the full report by Raymond Chabot Grant Thorton;

WHEREAS the elected council has attended MRC consultation meetings within the MRC Pontiac;

WHEREAS the Bristol Council has met with the Municipalities of Clarendon and Shawville and have also participated in a joint community consultation meeting with the same municipalities;

THEREFORE Motion Cr. Graham that because of the enormous opposition to any style or form of amalgamation which involves the Municipality of Bristol; the Municipality of Bristol Council is opposed to amalgamation with any other municipality. The Municipality of Bristol will continue with their inter-municipal agreements with other municipalities and will work to improve on agreements when necessary. Crd. Unanimously.

**(13-06-94)** Motion Cr. O'Malley to install two Caution Children at Play signs near 18 Eighth Line. Crd. The Mayor abstains from voting.

**(13-06-95)** Motion Cr. Graham to forward the budgeted amount of \$5000 for the Sault-Des-Chats project without the feasibility study as requested. Motion defeated. 1 in favour and 5 against.

Drummond to pay the entire invoice for the training course for the By-Law Enforcement Officer / Assistant Building Inspector Isabelle Lajoie scheduled for June 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup>, concerning Methods and Techniques for Building Inspections and she will not submit an invoice for her hours or mileage associated with this course.
